



## BIDDING RULES

1. The Bid Book will include:
  - a. All paintings for sale, listed by artist, with painting number corresponding to a painting label.
  - b. Instructions to Buyers and Artists for the bidding process, including bidder's legal obligation to complete and pay for each winning bid.
  - c. Page per painting in each artist's section with space for
    - i. For artist's estimated value and, minimum/starting bid,
    - ii. For Bidder's bid and email/phone contact info.
2. Bidding and Sales are completed as follows
  - a. For Wet Room:
    - i. Bidders will place bid amount and contact information on the painting's page in the Bid Book, equal or more than the higher of the minimum bid or the previous highest bid.
    - ii. Bidding closes at 3:00 pm on Saturday, subject to sale at the Gala or unless otherwise noted on the Bid Sheet.
  - b. For Gala:
    - i. Bidding continues for Gala attendees during the Gala.
    - ii. Paintings placed for judging will be placed on four walls in the Gala Venue, with all award winners moved to one wall after judging.
    - iii. Gala bidding begins at 6. Winning bidders are announced at close of bidding for the respective paintings.
      1. Judging and awards at 6:30
      2. Award winning paintings and corresponding bid sheets will be moved to the fourth wall
      3. Bidding closes on first wall at 7:15
      4. Second wall at 7:30
      5. Third wall at 7:45
      6. Fourth wall (of winning paintings) closes at 8
    - iv. Gala attendees can pay and take paintings with them.
    - v. Payment and pick up table will open at 7:15.
  - c. Saturday View and Sale:
    - i. Paintings not sold at the Gala are open for view and bid from 11 until 3:00
    - ii. Bids close at 3:00 and bidder's purchases must be completed between 3:00 and 5:00.
